 Upgrade, Software Signature Command Signature Change, and License files
 and upload Audit Log Export over HTTP / HTTPS via the TACLANE-10G's interface.
- Remote HMI: Remote users can access the TACLANE HMI over HTTPS using the TACLANE-10G's PT interface and using a web browser, the user can connect to the TACLANE using their username and password for authentication.
- Multicast Source IP Replacement: Option to replace IP version 4 (IPv4) or IP version 6 (IPv6) unicast source IP address for PT egress multicast UDP packets with TACLANE's PT IP address.
- SAs in Progress: Displays counts of the SAs which are currently in progress for IKEv1 and IKEv2 (IKE and Child) SAs in order to assist in trouble-shooting SA negotiation issues.
