## GEM® One Enterprise Encryptor Manager Release 2.6

General Dynamics Mission Systems adds new network management enhancements and expanded device support in the GEM One Release 2.6 software update. The new R2.6 includes expanded management for additional HAIPE and EDE device releases, added features and continued improvements to security and performance.

## R2.6 includes the following new features:

- Automatic Field Software Upgrade (FSU): Provides a streamlined FSU process to automatically download files, install files, and restart devices.
- Trigger Tasks: Enables scheduled tasks for unreachable devices to run when devices become reachable again.
- Group Operations: Allows users to perform enterprise operations on a custom group of devices instead of individual devices. These operations include transferring keys, refresh of Key Manager, retrieving Audit Logs and more.
- Forward to Syslog: Enables GEM One to forward data to Syslog collectors. Data that can be forwarded to Syslog includes Audit Log Archives, AAS Alerts, TTS Alerts and GEM One Event Logs.
